There are a bunch of elves busily working to make sure that Surface Creek area families have a wonderful holiday this year. Volunteers with the Surface Creek Community Services – Cedaredge Food Bank are preparing Christmas dinner boxes for local families. The boxes include either a turkey or a ham, and all the fixings to prepare traditional Christmas feast, including rolls, two or three side dishes, and two desserts. Volunteers are preparing 250 boxes between now and Dec. 14, when boxes will be given to families.

"The holidays can be really stressful for families in need," said Mary Gotchey, a board member for SCCS. "To give this gift of a holiday meal so that our neighbors can celebrate the holiday like other families is really something special."

You can mail a check to Surface Creek Community Services, P.O. Box 963, Cedaredge CO 81413, or drop off your check or cash payment at Cedaredge Town Hall. Make sure to note on the memo line "Christmas food boxes."
