## 2020 Municipal Election!

## Inflationary Rate Increase

The Board of Trustees approved a utility rate increase of 3% on water and sewer base fees via Resolution 16-2019. The typical utility customer will see an increase of \$1.89 per month starting January 2020.

## Utility Relief

The Board of Trustees has authorized utility relief for those individuals or families in need of assistance for 2020. The Town provides customers receiving LEAP (Low-Income Energy Assistance Program) through the State of Colorado with utility relief vouchers for water and/or sewer utilities for the Town of Cedaredge. ## Snow is Coming! 2 Reminders!
