A Note From The Mayor

As a citizen, you own a town called Cedaredge!

You own a town hall, civic center, public works buildings, water treatment plant, wastewater treatment facility, two water storage tanks (one hot and one cold!), one main park, pocket parks, a skate park, a golf course, 17 miles of streets, a beautiful trail system, work trucks, police vehicles, and too many implements to count!

You have 24 full time, 4 part time, and around 24 seasonal employees:

Police Department – 1 chief, 1 sergeant, 4 officers, and 1.5 administrative assistants, 1 part time clerk of court (also the deputy town clerk), and 1 part time municipal judge.

Golf Course – 1 pro/manager, 1 course superintendent, and around 24 part time/seasonal employees

Administration – 1 town administrator, 1 town clerk/economic development coordinator, 1 deputy town clerk, 1 finance director, and 1 part time building inspector

Public Works – 2 co-directors, 2.5 water treatment operators, 1.5 wastewater treatment operators, 3.5 public works employees (these are the people who take care of your water lines, sewer lines, street repairs and general town maintenance)

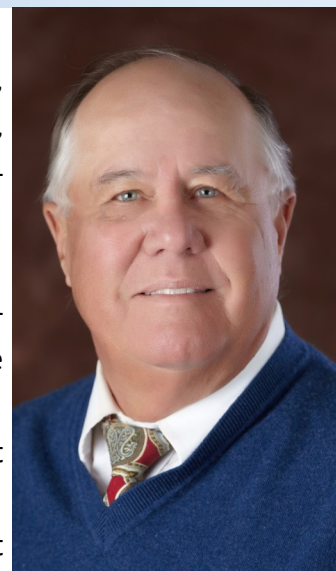
Wow! You own a LOT! Be involved in managing your assets!

You also own the revenue and expenditures of the Town. The Town publishes your annual budgets, monthly financial statements and annual audits conducted by a neutral third party, all of which is available on the Town's website.

So, now that you own a Town with all of these assets, you are responsible to hire employees to manage your town, and they need competitive salaries and benefits. Here is the punchline: to manage your budget and your assets, you need a Board of Trustees and a Mayor. You have the opportunity to vote for who you want to manage your Town on April 7, 2020.

Be involved! Come to meetings. Come to budget meetings. Be involved and active in the selection of the people you choose to run your Town and manage your assets.
