

Did You Know?

Did you know that the Surface Creek Valley is home to the Zeta Omicron chapter of Epsilon Sigma Alpha, an international leadership and service organization? In 1970 Mary Lou Huerkamp was a member of the Delta chapter of the ESA sorority and felt there was a need for a more local chapter in the Surface Creek Valley. She gathered a group of ladies and organized the Zeta Omicron chapter, which continues to be a positive influence today. Our parent organization, ESA, was founded in 1929 in Jacksonville, Texas, by a small group of ladies wishing to bring more cultural and educational opportunities to women of that day and age. What started in one small town has today expanded into a worldwide educational and philanthropic/service organization.

Locally, Zeta Omicron sponsors and carries out two major functions each year to fund work within the community. The first is the Irish Stew, this year on March 13, proceeds of which fund a vocational scholarship for a local student. The second is the Edge of the Cedars Art Show in early June, a show Zeta Omicron has organized for nearly 50 years! This art show provides a place for local artists as well as those from other areas of the Western Slope to display and sell their work. Entry fees and commissions from any sales provide a scholarship for a graduating senior interested in art. Not only do we strive to support the two scholarships for graduating seniors each year, we also, on a yearly basis, pretty much empty our treasury by donating to various community and nonprofit organizations, including the food bank, library, fire department, the animal shelter, various school programs and others. This fall we also participated in "Hope for Heroes" by sending packages to two local servicemen deployed overseas (photo above).



What we do is possible only through the generosity and support we receive from the residents in the Surface Creek Valley.
