



Want To Run For Office?

The Town of Cedaredge will hold municipal elections on April 5, 2022. Five positions are available: the office of Mayor and four Trustees. The Mayor and one Trustee seat will each serve a two year term; the remaining three Trustees will each serve a four year term.

In order to qualify to run for office you must:

- Be at least 18 years of age at the time of election
- Be a registered voter
- Have been a resident of the Town of Cedaredge for the last 12 consecutive months, and you must remain a full time resident during your entire term
- May not be a paid employee of the Town of Cedaredge, nor may you apply for paid employment during your term, if elected

The Mayor and Trustees of the Town of Cedaredge are responsible for:

- Representing the best interests of your entire constituency
- Policymaking and legislative powers of the Town
- Setting the annual budget to support policy decisions
- Attending the twice-monthly Board meetings (first and third Thursdays) and other committee meetings as assigned

Desirable leadership attributes of successful candidates:

- General understanding of municipal government
- Willingness to listen and to understand
- Willingness to learn about a wide variety of topics
- Integrity and consistency
- Strong communication skills
- Being approachable and accessible

In order to run in the election, you must:

- Circulate a nomination petition and gather 25 signatures of registered electors residing within Town boundaries
- You may pick up and begin circulating a nomination packet on Tuesday, Jan. 4, 2022.
- Nomination petitions are due by 4 pm on Monday, Jan. 24, 2022. Packets must be returned to the Town Clerk's office and will not be accepted after this date.
